#### **City of Calgary launches Secondary Suite Incentive Program**

The City of Calgary is proud to introduce the Secondary Suite Incentive Program, an initiative aimed at encouraging safe and accessible housing for Calgarians.

The Secondary Suite Incentive Program is a component of Home is Here: The City of Calgary's Housing Strategy. It provides a qualifying homeowner up to \$10,000 to cover a portion of construction costs to develop and register a safe secondary suite.

The incentive applies to suites built within the main dwelling, not for backyard or detached suites. Applications are limited to one per person and you must own the property through the entire process. Qualifying homeowners with an active building permit can apply for the following:

- · Egress windows
- Hardwired and interconnected smoke and carbon monoxide alarms
- · Protected exiting
- · Smoke-tight barriers
- Split heat/separate air
- Additional funding is available for accessibility and energy efficiency

The Secondary Suite Incentive Program is open for applications. Learn more about the program or apply at <u>calgary.ca/suite-incentive</u>.

#### Accidental Poisoning



Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and caregivers of precautions they can take to prevent accidental childhood poisonings around the home. Ingesting prescription or over-the-counter (OTC) medications is a significant cause of accidental childhood poisonings. Other causes include ingesting or contact with household items such as dishwasher or laundry tablets, mouthwash, or chemicals such as paints, solvents, or cleaning products.

#### Medication storage

- Place all medications in locked containers and store in an area inaccessible to children:
- For easy identification, store all medications in their original packaging; do not mix multiple medications in a single bottle;
- Install child locks on all cabinets, or drawers where medications are stored.

#### Safety tips

- Child-resistant medication bottles are not child proof. They can still be opened by a child;
- Take extra precaution with medicines designed to appeal to children such as chewable vitamins or flavored cough and cold syrups:
- Promptly dispose of any medications or toxic household products no longer in use.

#### Prevention

- · Store household products. cleaning supplies, and cosmetics in locked cabinets or drawers;
- Install child latches on cabinets children might also access by climbing on counters or chairs;
- Label all plants in and around your home and garden;
- Antifreeze, windshield washer fluid, and pesticides are extremely poisonous. Even small amounts of these can cause serious illness if ingested;
- Poisoning information can be obtained by calling the Poison and Drug Information Service (PADIS) at: 1-800-332-1414;
- In case of a poisoning emergency, call 9-1-1; Provide the name of the product ingested and, if it is safe to do so, a sample of the substance for EMS to inspect on their arrival.



#### **Gardeners Corner**

Please come visit our gardens! We want our gardens to bring enjoyment and inspiration to everyone in the community, whether you're a gardener or not. Everything is coming into its peak production with the recent heat, and it can be really relaxing to sit and eat your lunch in the garden.



With our current weather and forecast, you will continue see a lot of quick growth in your plants this month, particularly in your heatloving plants like tomatoes and beans. Just remember to put up a cage for plants that need a little extra support and take a few minutes to install a small fence around your bed if it is at ground level – rabbits can destroy your plants in a few minutes!

With our record-breaking heat and typical Calgary winds, your raised beds will dry out very quickly. It is recommended to give your garden a full inch of water several times a week – as much as every day if it

is extra hot and dry. Please consider purchasing a rain barrel, now is a great time to start brainstorming some new ideas to put into place for next year based on what you're struggling with now.

#### **Oral Health Care for Older Adult**

A recent Statistics Canada report, "Access to specialized health-care services among older Canadians," highlights that older women face greater challenges than men in accessing medical specialists and non-emergency tests. The study, which analyzed data from the 2019-2020 Canadian Health Survey on Seniors, found that women aged 65 and older were significantly less likely than men to visit specialists or undergo necessary medical tests. This gap in access can result in delayed diagnoses and treatments, contributing to higher incidences of conditions like dementia among older women. Dr. Samir Sinha, director of geriatrics at Sinai Health and the University Health Network, points out that this issue leads to increased disability and poorer health outcomes for older women.






The report also notes that Canada's aging population is growing, with 18.5 percent of Canadians aged 65 or older in 2021, a percentage projected to rise to between 21.4 percent and 23.4 percent by 2030. This demographic shift, driven by the aging baby boomer population, increased life expectancy, and declining fertility rates, is expected to surge the demand for elder-specialized healthcare services. However, many older Canadians report difficulties in accessing these services, owing to long wait times, challenges in getting referrals, and availability issues. Women, particularly those who are caregivers and less financially secure, face additional

barriers such as transportation costs and time constraints, further widening the access gap.

Experts like Laura Tamblyn-Watts, CEO of CanAge, emphasize the increase impact of ageism and gender discrimination in healthcare. Older women often do not have their pain and symptoms taken seriously, leading to misdiagnoses or conditions going undetected. Immigrant women, especially those from non-European countries, face further obstacles due to cultural, language, and financial barriers. Early detection and appropriate treatment are crucial for improving health outcomes and quality of life for older women. Dr. Sinha and Tamblyn-Watts advocate for more research to understand and address these barriers, ensuring that older women receive the specialized care they need.

Alberta's government will address the challenges posed by the surge in student enrollment by investing \$215 million and will focus on both new construction and relocation of modular classrooms. The government is aiming to provide relief to the educational system while accommodating the needs of a growing student population. Additionally, up to 50 existing modular classrooms will be relocated to rapidly growing areas like the Calgary Metropolitan Region and Edmonton which will support up to 1,250 students. School authorities can also use this additional funding to hire more teachers and classroom support staff, which will help them manage class sizes, and tackle rising cost pressures without taking away from student learning.

Every Albertan should feel safe and protected in their community. Therefore, my ministry has created a new Alberta Advantage Immigration Program (AAIP) pathway specifically for law enforcement. The government of Alberta is adding necessary supports for Alberta's police services to meet their recruitment objectives for public protection and addressing crime. To support this, the AAIP is providing up to 50 nominations from its limited allocation pool to support Alberta's law enforcement sector. To qualify, applicants must have a job offer and a qualifying federal Express Entry profile. The AAIP helps strengthen and grow the province's economy by helping address labour challenges across all sectors, including law enforcement.

Thank you to all those who invited me to events during Stampede and throughout the summer. I had a lot of fun and met so many incredible people. These events cannot happen without the tremendous help of volunteers who make it possible. Kudos to all of you!

#### **Secondary Suite Incentive Program Launch**

To encourage safe and accessible housing, the City has launched its Secondary Suite Incentive Program as part of our official Housing Strategy. It provides qualifying homeowners with up to \$10,000 to cover a portion of costs to develop and register and safe suite. Only suites built within main dwellings are eligible to apply for the following:

- Egress windows
- Hardwired and interconnected smoke and carbon monoxide alarms
- Protected exiting
- Smoke-tight barriers
- Split heat/separate air

Additional funding is also available for accessibility and energy efficiency. View the full details and application process at calgary.ca/suite-incentive.


