



Window & Balcony Safety

With the return of warmer weather, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and caregivers of an often-overlooked hazard in the home – access to open windows. Every year, paramedics respond to emergencies where a child has fallen from an open window, often from the second floor. These can be mitigated by following safety measures. Take the time to assess potential window and balcony hazards in your home before a preventable fall occurs.

#### Windows and screens

- Prevent access to windows by moving furniture such as cribs, beds, stools, and change tables out from under them;
- Keep drapery cords out of childrens' reach. Wrap excess cord around cleats, or tie-downs to avoid a choking hazard;
- Remember, screens are not safety devices. They are designed to keep bugs out, not children in.

#### Balconies

- Do not underestimate a child's ability to climb. Furniture and other items stored on balconies and decks can be used to climb resulting in falls over the railing;
- Ensure that your balcony railings are not more than 10 cm (4 inch) apart. This will eliminate access between the vertical bars of a balcony, or deck.

#### Further prevention tips

- Toddlers & preschoolers are at highest risk of falling from a window, or balcony, but it may happen at any age;
- Direct supervision of children is the single most effective way to prevent falls from windows and balconies;
- Install safety devices which limit the distance in which a window be can open to a maximum of 10cm (4 inches);
- Ensure the safety device can be released quickly, so the window can be used for escape in case of emergency.
- Consider purchasing a portable air conditioner, which will enable windows to stay closed & secure.

## Waste and Recycling

## Park cart smart

When you set out your blue, green and black carts properly, you're helping to ensure safe and efficient operation of The City's waste collection trucks. That includes how you park on the street outside your home, especially in cul-de-sacs. A few simple reminders will help make everyone's day go smoothly:

• **Parking in a cul-de-sac:** All vehicles must be parallel parked with passenger side wheels to the curb, unless there are signs permitting angle parking. This helps collection trucks reach your carts and turn around in a cul-de-sac.

- Place your carts on flat ground, one metre away from your vehicle if parked on the street.
- Improperly parked vehicles block driveways for residents and restrict access for emergency and waste management vehicles.

**Parking in an alley:** Do not block the end of a closed alley with parked vehicles. Collection trucks need space to turn around safely.

These simple but important steps help ensure safe and efficient cart collection.



# **Good Food-Recipe Central**

BBQ One-Skillet Shrimp & Asparagus Winner: Rhonda Bjorklund

MAY WINNER!

Serves: 4

save m food

1/4 cup olive oil
1/2 lb asparagus spears. trimmed and cut into 2 in. pieces
1 cup cherry tomatoes
1 lb (500 g) shrimp thawed (16 to 20 count) peeled and deveined
4 cloves garlic minced
1/2 tsp salt
1/4 tsp hot pepper flakes
3 tbsp lemon juice
1/4 cup finely chopped fresh parsley

## Directions

Heat 10 in cast-iron skillet on grill preheated to medium-high. Add oil. Sauté asparagus and tomatoes 3 to 5 min. until they begin to char.

Stir in shrimp, garlic, salt and hot pepper flakes. Cook 3 to 5 min. until shrimp turns pink and opaque.

Just before serving, mix in lemon juice 2 tbsp water and sprinkle with parsley.




All garden plot rentals require an <u>NHCA membership</u>, valid until Oct 31st.

## Learning how to Remember

Do you sometimes have problems remembering things that were just told to you? A name, a detail, a word? Well, you're not alone. This feeling where you just can't remember is called "blocking," which is essentially diminished memory recall.

But why does this happen? Well, as your brain ages, its ability to easily recall information tends to weaken. Lydia Cho, a psychologist at McLean Hospital, details that the brain shrinks about 5% every decade after you turn 40, with the regression speeding up when you hit 70. A smaller brain means there are fewer neurotransmitters to carry signals between brain cells. This makes the brain less efficient. Cho also suggests certain habits and conditions contribute to blocking, such as depression, stress, lack of exercise, etc. Even though all of these factors can occur naturally, it doesn't mean you can't improve your ability to recall.



The next time when you are struggling to remember information, try giving your brain "hints" about what you want to recall. To do this, try the following strategies:

<u>Create association</u>: When you learn something new, try to associate it with something you already know. A strong association can help your brain recall the idea later.

• For example, Sally is your friend's sister. Your brain is more likely to remember the name Sally since it is associated with something familiar, your friend.

Look, snap, connect: This practice involves paying attention in the moment of learning something new and then using imagining to solidify your memory.

• For example, you park your car in section 4B of a parking garage. In terms of this method, "Look" refers to what you are supposed to remember (4B), and "Snap" means that you are attempting to remember the information. Finally, "Connect" involves associating the information with something else (4B = 4 Bananas).

<u>Retrieving words and memories</u>: When you are trying to retrieve the right word or memory, pausing and giving your brain time to focus allows it to send the necessary signals to obtain information.

<u>Brute force</u>: Sometimes, if you skip over the mental barrier and just ramble around the conversation, you give your brain time to think and find the correct information.

As of April 1st when seniors visit their preferred registry office, they will be eligible for a discount on services like vehicle registration renewals, driver's licenses, standard plates and vital statistics products like marriage licenses. Eligible seniors must be a resident of Alberta and 65 years of age or older on the day they purchase the registry services.

Alberta's government is working to ensure every Albertan receives required surgeries within clinically recommended wait times. The latest waitlist data shows more Albertans are receiving their surgeries within clinically recommended times than at any time since 2020. The government will also continue to invest in acute care, prioritizing initiatives like the Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment (FAST) program and Rapid Access Clinic pilot to reduce surgical wait times.
